**WHEREAS**, the Township Board New Haven Township wishes to provide SATA (Shiawassee Area Transportation Agency) Public Transportation; and

**WHEREAS**, townships may impose and levy ad valorem property taxes to finance lawful public services, as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Board of New Haven Township wishes to levy, .333 mills to provide SATA (Shiawassee Area Transportation Agency) public transportation;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Township Board of New Haven Township, Shiawassee County, approves the following millage ballot question language and directs the Clerk to submit it to be placed on the March 10, 2020

**Ballot Proposal**

Shall New Haven Township levy up to 1/3 of a mill (.333 cents per \$1,000.00 taxable value of real property) each year on an ad valorem basis, for a term of four (4) years (2020, 2021, 2022, 2023)? Such millage to be used to provide funding to the Shiawassee Area Transportation Agency (SATA) so that Township residents can ride public transportation at a reduced charge.

It is estimated that the Township will receive up to \$15, 497.00 the first year if the millage is Approved


