

RESOLUTION TO ADOPT MILLAGE BALLOT LANGUAGE

New Haven Township, Shiawassee County Resolution Number 2020-04

WHEREAS, the Township Board of New Haven Township wishes to provide Township Road Maintenance;

and WHEREAS, townships may provide Township Road Maintenance, as authorized by Public Act 116 of 1923, MCL 41.411 (indicate the statute that authorizes a township to do the purpose of the millage);

WHEREAS, townships may contract and cooperate with other entities to provide Township Road Maintenance as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws;

and WHEREAS, townships may impose and levy ad valorem property taxes to finance lawful public services, as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws;

and WHEREAS, the Township Board of New Haven Township, Shiawassee County, Michigan wishes to levy 2 mills to provide Township Road Maintenance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Board of New Haven Township, Shiawassee County, Michigan approves the following millage ballot question language and directs the Clerk to submit it to be placed on the November 3, 2020, election ballot:

Shall the New Haven Township continue to levy a total of two mill (\$2.00 per \$1,000.00) on taxable value of property located in the New Haven Township, Shiawassee County for five years beginning with the 2020 tax levy year and running through 2026 tax levy year (inclusive), which will raise in the first year of such levy an estimated revenue of [Dollars \$100,000.00] to be used for the specific purpose of Road repairs and maintenance. If approved this would be a renewal of a previously authorized millage.
