RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A RESIDENT TAXPAYER TO FILE A PROTEST BEFORE THE BOARD OF REVIEW BY LETTER WITHOUT A PERSONAL APPEARANCE.

WHEREAS, MCL 211.30(8), permits a township to authorize a resident taxpayer to file his or her protest before the Board of Review by letter without a personal appearance by the taxpayer or his or her agent, and

WHEREAS, the Assessor recommends that a resident taxpayer be allowed to file his or her protest before the Board of Review without making a personal appearance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the township authorizes a resident taxpayer to file his or her protest before the Board of Review by letter without a personal appearance by the taxpayer or his or her agent, and township will notify taxpayers of this option on each assessment notice and publication of the meeting of the board of review. This resolution is for the year 2021 and will expire December 31, 2021.
