RESOLUTION TO ADOPT GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT 2022-03

WHEREAS, this resolution is to establish a general appropriations act for New Haven Township; to define the powers and duties of the New Haven Township Officers in relation to the administration of the budget, and to provide remedies for refusal or neglect to comply with the requirements of this resolution.

The New Haven Township Board ordains:

Section 1: Title

This resolution shall be known as the New Haven Township General Appropriations Act 2022.

Section 2: Public Hearings on the Budget

Pursuant to MCLA 141.412, notice of a public hearing on the proposed budget was published in a newspaper of general circulation on February 10, 2022 and a public hearing on the proposed budget was held on March 14, 2022.

Section 3: Millage Levy

The New Haven Township Board shall cause to be levied and collected the general property tax on all real and personal property within the township upon the current tax roll in amount of 1 Mill as set forth by the Tax Allocation Board and as authorized under State Law. The Road millage was approved by the electorate at the November 3, 2020 General Election for 2 mills. As approved in a Special Fire Assessment Levy Hearing on October 29, 1996 of 1 Mill on Taxable Value. Ambulance Special Assessment Levy on October 2013 of \$45 per household. Shiawassee Area Transportation Agency as approved by the electorate at the March 10, 2020 Primary Election up to 1/3 Mill on Taxable Real Value.

Section 4: Adoption of Budget by Reference

The General Fund, 2-Mill Fund, Fire Fund, Ambulance Fund, and SATA (Shiawassee Area Transportation Agency) Fund budgets of New Haven Township are hereby adopted by reference, with revenues and expenditures and disbursements. Township officials shall exercise supervision and control to ensure that expenditures are within appropriations, and shall not issue any town order for expenditures that exceed appropriations. Section 5: Authorized Salary, hourly and per diem rates
